







CATERPILLARS

- Coffeeberry-*Frangula californica*: Pale Swallowtail Butterfly
- Cow Parsnip-*Heracleum maximum*: Anise Swallowtail Butterfly
- Ocean Spray-*Holodiscus discolor*: Pale Swallowtail Butterfly
- Silverbush Lupine-*Lupinus albifrons*: Boisduval's Blue Butterfly
- Yampah-*Perideridia kelloggii*: Anise Swallowtail Butterfly
